Furthermore, I agree to advise my child's coach at the beginning of each season of any and all medical conditions that may affect their participation. However, I am responsible to be at practices and games as their special conditions require. In my absence, I hereby give consent for emergency medical transport and care prescribed by a duly licensed Doctor of Medicine or Doctor of Dentistry and agree to be responsible for all associated costs. This care may be given under whatever conditions are necessary to preserve the life, limb or well being of my dependent. By participating in games or events, the DSL may use photos or videos taken of games and surrounding activities for publicity unless otherwise specified by the parent/guardian, annually, in writing. Programs for 2010 – 2011 are available to all youth within the Dublin area with birth dates between August 1st 1991 and July 31st 2006. Birth date determines age group for placement. U5 (Timbits) and High School are coed.

The eight week fall season Saturday games begin September 11th and conclude October 30th. The seven week spring season begins in April and concludes before Memorial Day. Games are played at either Avery Park or Darree Fields. All practice times and locations are scheduled at the discretion of the coach.

Register:

By mail: Make check payable to DSL and send to Dublin Soccer League, PO Box 501, Dublin, OH 43017.

In person: Forms may be picked up and/or dropped off at the DSL office, 37 W. Bridge St., Dublin, on Thursdays, 11 – 5. Registrations also accepted on Saturdays through May 22nd at Avery Park (equipment room of the concession stand). Checks or cash only are accepted at this time.

Online: coming soon—visit the website for the latest information.

Registrations must be **received by June 15th**. Late registrations (except high school) will be charged an additional \$25. Due to the popularity of the Recreational League, late registrations will be placed on a wait list and **may only** be accepted if space allows. **Register early** to secure a spot.

Fees: Fees vary based on the program and season/s selected. Participants may sign up for a single season or both seasons during the registration period. Players registered only for fall receive a reminder notice about spring fees.

Team Formation: To create teams, individual players are placed based on age group and gender (draft utilized in U9 and U10). Rosters are distributed to coaches in mid August and players contacted.

Uniforms: Shirt and socks are included in basic program fees—to be used for both fall and spring seasons.

Refunds: Fees will be refunded if DSL is unable to place your child on a DSL team. Submitting a registration form signifies your intent to participate in DSL.

Volunteers

DSL is primarily a volunteer organization and its continued success and reasonable rates depend upon the efforts of those that volunteer. Please read through the list of volunteer activities and select the one(s) that best suit(s) your interests, abilities, and availability. Some activities require only a few volunteers while others require many.

- **Coach:** Parents, including those with no prior experience, are encouraged to join the ranks of our coaches. You provide the interest; we'll provide the training. With a Saturday game and one practice during the week, the time commitment is approximately 3 hours per week during the season.
- **Coach Mentor:** Assist with confirming coach volunteers, recruiting new coach volunteers, mentoring and organizing clinics. Time commitment is highest during late June, early July and late August.
- **Practice Areas:** Monitor goal safety, condition of fields, and assess ongoing equipment needs. Time commitment is highest just prior to each season and periodically during the season.
- **Office/Registration:** Assist with processing of forms, data entry, and uniform order. Time commitment is highest in May and June, then again when uniforms come in.
- **Communications:** Assist with publications and mailings. Attend city recreation meetings and keep DSL apprised of discussions or actions that may affect DSL. Time commitment varies with meeting agendas.
- **Charity Cup Tournament:** Assist with planning for the tournament (held Saturday and Sunday of Labor Day weekend), mailings, concessions (securing vendors, supplies), field supervision, clean up, etc.
- **Long Range Planning:** Assist with assessing and developing programs, reviewing field concerns and other resources to continue providing quality community soccer.
- **Board Member:** Elections are held annually after nominating petitions are submitted and candidacy is verified. For additional information, please visit the website or contact the DSL office.
